This refers to any specific contraindications for implementing the procedure or intervention. Patient/legal guardian/substitute decision maker refusal of treatment is a general limitation. Preoperative pregnancy testing may not be possible in emergency situations in which patients require immediate surgical intervention.

Female patients are excluded from preoperative pregnancy testing if they:

Do not meet inclusion criteria, or:

- 1. Have results of a preoperative pregnancy test that has been performed in the last four days,
- 2. Have had a hysterectomy,
- 3. Are pre-menarchal (have not yet started having periods), or
- 4. Are post-menopausal (**no periods for one yea**r *and* older than age 50)

Preoperative pregnancy testing may not be possible in emergency situations in which patients require immediate surgical intervention.

- The purpose of testing has been explained
- Consent has been obtained

Communication	

Following QHC documentation policy and CNO standards, the nurse will document the appropriate assessments, treatments, patient responses and outcomes.

The Same Day Surgery Nurse will communicate the results of the pregnancy test to the attending surgeon; positive test results require a conversation with the attending surgeon and anesthesiologist to establish plan of care. Patients cannot proceed to the Operating Room until the test results are known.
