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TERMS OF REFERENCE

Inter-Professional Practice Council

Revised: July 29, 2020

Purpose

The Inter-Professional Practice Council provides a forum to support and guide joint accountability in professional practice within an inter-professional environment. The council will support the ability to maintain a dynamic practice environment and address the planning of professional development initiatives.

Objectives

- Guide the delivery of inter-professional, collaborative, patient-centered care based on best available evidence and enable health care professionals to work to their full scope of practice.
- Receive an annual overview of HSN's strategic directions and priorities which impact inter-professional practice.
- Develop an action plan that includes promoting, developing, implementing and evaluating professional activities and opportunities for inter-professional practice.
- Advocate for, and support, the achievement of quality assurance processes for each regulated health profession.
- Develop and implement an ongoing communication plan to advise inter-professionals about the work of the Council.
- Support and promote mentorship and preceptorship initiatives within the organization.
- Fostering relationships with HSNRI and other research institutions to promote intra/intraprofessional research initiatives.
- Ensure professional practice activities are aligned with legislative and regulatory practice standards.
- Help to define skills and competencies of health professionals to maintain and promote quality care within HSN.
- Provide support, guidance related to the implementation of electronic health records.

Accountability

Quorum

Quorum will be obtained when there are 50% +1 members in attendance.

Bi-monthly, or at the call of the Chair.

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
