Appendix A, Policy OH&S 6.5/IPAC 3-36 Departmental Protective Equipment Needs Assesment and Selection

- 1. In order to assess the need for a mask, conduct a walk-through survey of the workplace to identify hazards that are both droplet and potentially infectious in nature. Consideration should be given to:
 - patient presence (known/known interactions with diagnosis).
 - potentially infectious (spray/splatter/airborne).
 - procedures performed in the work environment.
 - is this work in an Operating Room or some other sterile environment or procedure?
 - is the patient a coughing risk?
 - can the patient be assessed to wear a mask according to their medical condition?
- 2. During the walk-through survey, be observant for:
 - sources of patient contact (duration, type, other controls).
 - sources of motion.
 - will visitors require similar precautions.
- 3. Review QHC standard/policies/resource manuals for further information and expectations.
- 4. Assess the hazards in the environment to properly select protective equipment and storage of masks. Consider the possibility of exposure to several hazards simultaneously.
- 5. Communicate mask protection requirements to all personnel and keep records of all communications.
- 6. Reassess workplace hazards annually, and as conditions/standards change.
- 7. Review same standards post-incident with the intent to improve the standard and/or compliance.
