APPENDIX F

Code White: Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (NCI) Training Levels

There are 4 levels of NVCI training:

- 1. NCI with Advanced Physical Skills: Designed for those individuals in departments with the most code whites. This course will teach you tools to lead a code white situation, use restraints and de-escalate aggressive situations.
- 2. **Nonviolent Crisis Intervention:** Designed for individuals in the Community Based Mental Health and Addiction Programs. This course will give you the tools to support descalating aggressive situations. This course does not provide training in the use of restraints.
- 3. **Verbal Intervention**: Designed for individuals in departments that will respond to code whites. This includes Housekeeping, etc. This course will give you the tools to support in a code white situation including de-escalating aggressive situations.
- 4. Nonviolent Crisis Intervention Awareness Working with Patients and Caregivers (An Approach to Safe De-Escalation): All other hospital staff and volunteers will participate in the on-line training that is focused at de-escalating situations and understanding the Code White policy.
